Proposed Research Plan

NB: this section is limited to 5 pages maximum (not including references), and should be completed in Font size 12, Times New Roman, single spacing, 2cm margins

1. The following sections **MUST** be included:

- Introduction: provide the rationale for the research
- Aims: clearly state the specific aims of the study and the hypothesis or hypotheses being tested
- Preliminary Results (if any): show preliminary results supporting the research plan
- Research Plan: explain the experimental design and the methods that will be used to achieve the study objectives. Anticipated results and potential pitfalls and alternative approaches should be briefly discussed.
- The research plan should include a description of relevant facilities/capabilities

- Please attach research proposal separately. Additional pages will be removed.

Mentor Support Letter

The mentor must provide a letter (on letterhead) outlining their commitment to support the applicant, and their role in the project.

- Please attach mentor support letter separately – only the first two (2) pages will be reviewed. Additional pages will be removed.
