

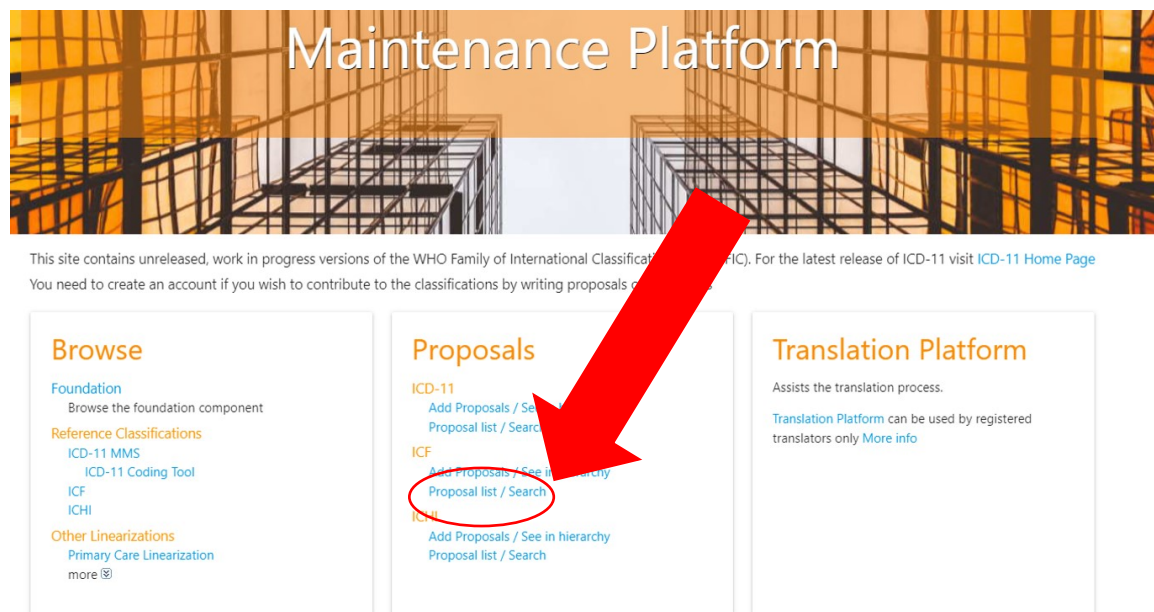

Intestinal Failure Associated Liver Disease (IFALD)

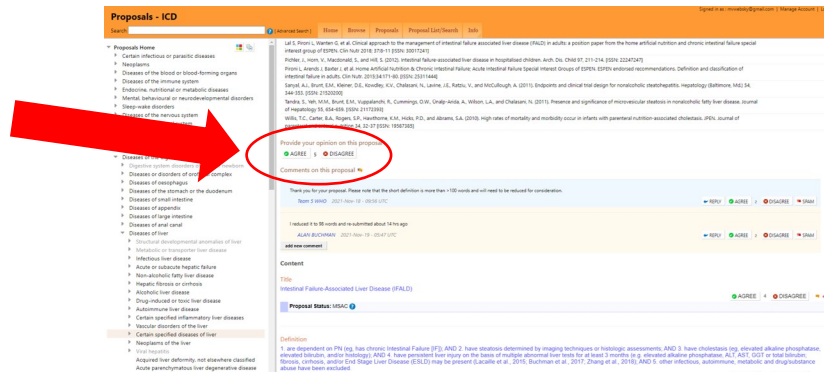
Proposal Status: MSAC

Definition

1 and dependent on PN (eg, has chronic Intestinal Failure [IF]); AND 2, have steatosis determined by imaging techniques or histologic assessments; AND 3, have cholestasis (eg, elevated alkaline phosphatase, elevated bilirubin, and/or histology); AND 4, have persistent liver injury on the basis of multiple abnormal liver tests for at least 3 months (e.g. elevated alkaline phosphatase, ALT, AST, GGT or total bilirubin, fibrosis, cirrhosis, and/or End Stage Liver Disease (ESLD) may be present (Lacaille et al., 2016; Buchman et al., 2017; Zhang et al., 2018); AND 5, other infectious, autoimmune, metabolic and drug/substance abuse have been excluded.

6. Then repeat your search for either “IFALD” or “short bowel syndrome” (whichever you did not yet vote on) and
